Performance Review

Cargo Throughput

FAP is continuously facilitating its customers as well as the industry by handling a variety of cargoes through a fast vessel turnaround time. During 3rd Qtr. (Jan - Mar 2023) the Terminal achieved a record-breaking quarterly throughput of around 1 million tons.

Supporting the efforts of the Government of Pakistan to address the National Wheat Shortage, FAP is consistently handling the bulk-wheat import for the past three years.

From Aug 22 till March 23, the Terminal efficiently handled 25 x vessels carrying around 1.6 million tons of bulk wheat imports.

Highest Monthly Throughput

During Feb 23, FAP successfully handled 7x vessels (4x wheat, 2x oilseed & 1x rice) with the highest monthly throughput of 409 KTN

Largest Dry Bulk Vessel berthed at FAP

On 9th Feb.23, FAP handled the largest dry bulk cargo vessel ever berthed in Pakistan in a record 3.3 days. MV VITUS BERING carrying 75,000 tons of wheat having LOA: 250m and beam: 43m.

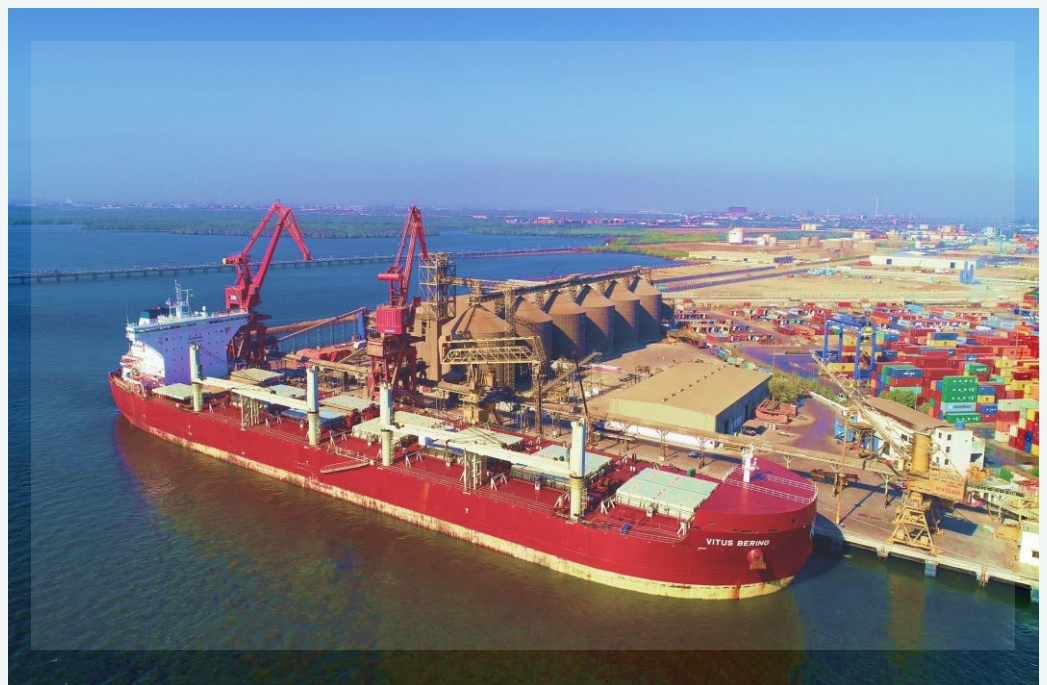
Highest Discharge

FAP accomplished a significant milestone on 4th Jan 23, by successfully unloading 34,760 metric tons within 24-hour from a gearless vessel MV LENI.

This achievement sets a new record for grain discharge, surpassing the industry standard by a substantial margin.

Highest Dispatch

Another landmark achieved by FAP on 27th Feb 23 i.e., the highest dispatch of 20,100 MT within 24 hours.



New Mobile Bagging Stations installed at FAP

FAP has recently installed 6x new mobile bagging stations having 12x bagging lines to facilitate its customers with direct bagging of non-free-flowing cargo such as DAP, PKE, etc.



Re-Export of Soybean

During Mar 23, FAP handled the 1st soybean re-export vessel of 56,285 tons, which was previously withheld by the National Food Security and Customs Intelligence due to restrictions on the import of GMO oilseed.



First Yellow Peas vessel Handled at FAP

During Mar 23, FAP efficiently handled its 1st Yellow Peas vessel of 40,260 mt within less than three days resulting in significant dispatch earnings for the importers.



FAP Participation in PIMEC 2023

In Feb 23, FAP actively participated in Pak Int'l Maritime Expo & Conf. (PIMEC) in collaboration with PQA. The enthusiastic involvement of FAP team received high appreciation from PQA.
